

Free parking

FREE disc parking is available in the majority of streets just outside the centre of Scarborough. On the map overleaf areas marked in red allow one hour free parking and areas marked in purple and orange allow two hours free parking and areas marked in green allow three hours free parking all by setting a disc clock when you arrive.

If you are unsure about the restrictions that apply on the street where you are parked then check the signs sited at regular intervals along each street or ring Customer First on 01723 232323. (9am–5pm Monday–Friday)



Disc clocks are available from the Tourist Information Centres, Council offices and dozens of shops, garages, office and public buildings in the area.

Resident's parking

Parking controls have been introduced to protect residents' parking areas in and around the town centre. Residents parking controls apply to all the streets coloured purple, orange, green and blue on our map overleaf.

Permits are issued to residents allowing them unrestricted parking and they can obtain guest permits for their visitors. Free disc parking is available in the orange, purple and green areas for two or three hours.

Holiday visitors

Visitor parking in Scarborough is now easier. If you are visiting Scarborough and intending to stay for a few nights then contact your hotel or guest house owner. The Council has contacted holiday accommodation owners to help them make arrangements.

Outside the town centre unrestricted parking for hotel guests is permitted, by means of a scratchcard, within the vicinity of your accommodation. Different arrangements apply in the Town Centre (blue) areas, your hotel will advise.

While looking for accommodation you can use disc clocks to get up to one, two or three hours of free parking – except in areas covered by our on-street pay and display meters.

Disabled badge holders

Disabled badge holders are exempt from the on-street parking controls and charges and are unaffected by the time restrictions that apply in disc zones. Many of the Council's Car Parks have specially marked spaces for disabled badge holders.

Disabled badge holders are NOT exempt from payment of parking charges on the pay and display off-street car parks.

ADVANCE TICKETS

2-7 day car parking tickets are available in advance from Tourist Information Centres or can be purchased when you arrive (day of issue free).



On-Street Parking

Free disc parking is available as follows. (Outside these hours, parking is unrestricted)

- Up to 1 hour between 9am and 5pm Mon-Sat 12 noon to 5pm Sunday. (permits & scratch cards are not valid in this zone)
- Up to 2 hours between 9am and 7pm Mon-Sat 12 noon to 7pm Sunday.
- Up to 2 hours between 9am and 5pm Mon-Sat 12 noon to 5pm Sunday.
- Up to 3 hours between 9am and 5pm Mon-Sat 12 noon to 5pm Sunday.

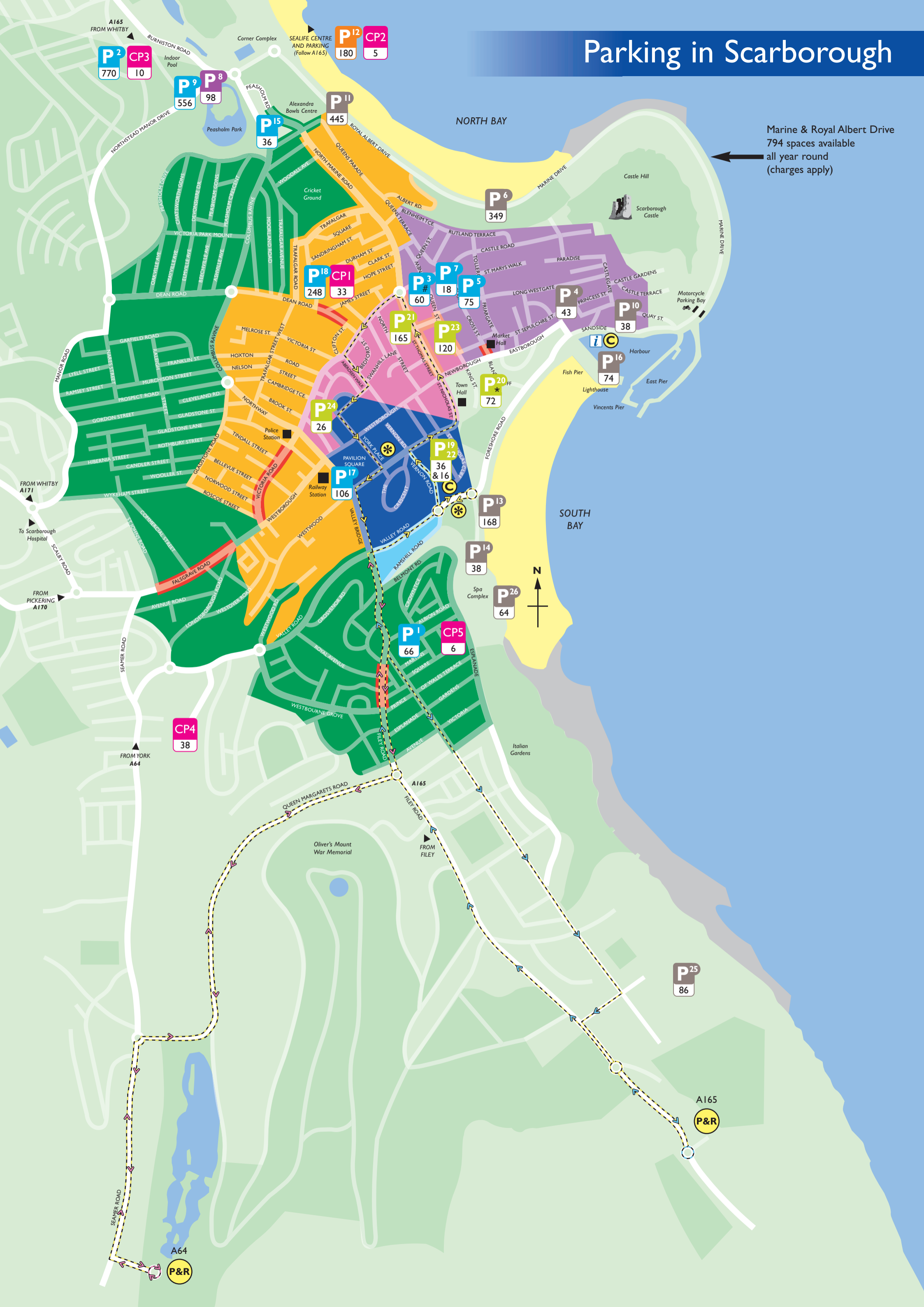
The charge for on-street parking is displayed at point of payment. Hours of operation are: between 9am and 6pm daily

- Up to 2 hours maximum stay
- Up to 4 hours maximum stay
- Up to 7 hours maximum stay
